A MESSAGE FROM OUR RECTOR

The Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time – February 04, 2024



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

On behalf of Bishop Vann, the Shepherd of our Diocese, and the Pastor of Christ Cathedral, I would like to welcome each of you to Christ Cathedral and thank you very much for choosing Christ Cathedral and celebrating with us your Sunday's worship!

WHAT IS OUR ATTITUDE? Job's attitude in striking contrast to Jesus' one. The first reading tells us that Job complains of the tedium and futility of life and the miseries of human existence. But eventually Job surrenders himself, his suffering, his work and everything he had and lost to the greater wisdom of God (Job 42:1-6). The responsorial psalm sings praises to God because He is busy full-time in gathering Israel from their captivity, healing the brokenhearted and bandaging their wounds, controlling the universe, and sustaining the lowly. The second reading presents Paul as a true and dynamic follower of Jesus, ready to do something extra for his Lord by preaching the Gospel without recompense. The Gospel teaches us that true discipleship means getting involved in giving selfless service to others via the perfect example of Jesus' day of ministry. He spent himself and most of his time ministering to the needs of others, giving healing, forgiveness and new beginning to many.

After receiving the Holy Communion, let us talk with Jesus in the Eucharist and ask him to strengthen our courage to avoid Job's pessimistic and cynical view of life as a chain of pain and sufferings, and to accept it as a precious gift of God with hope and optimism, by doing good to others and spending our time, treasure, talents and lives for others as Jesus did and as St. Paul did.

PASTORAL SERVICES APPEAL. The annual Diocese of Orange Pastoral Services Appeal, or PSA, is one important way we share Christ's light in our community and inspire others to do the same. Each year, the PSA provides essential funding to support formation, education, and outreach across our Diocese. Alma was born and raised Catholic but grew up in a household filled with fighting and abuse. Despite attending Mass regularly, she didn't have a deep relationship with Jesus Christ.

At the age of 17, she joined the Marine Corps to escape her home life and travel the world. While on active duty, her life took a turn when she met and married her husband and faced a series of challenges, including marital problems, and health issues. During her time in the military, she discovered Yoga. She became a Yoga instructor but eventually realized its connection to Hindu spirituality and discovered that it was leading her further away from God. She turned to prayer and adoration to find deliverance, consolation, and healing.

After a marriage retreat, she and her husband experienced spiritual awakenings, leading them to renew their faith and reject destructive influences. They went on to serve in a marriage ministry helping troubled marriages and became involved in the 40 Days for Life campaign.
